Sustainable Fine Avant Garde Millinery Workshop - Material List

The techniques learnt in this workshop applies in different ways across your Sustainable Millinery making; with your own fabulous twist

Basic:

6 -10 Stack of Old Newspapers to begin.

Stage 3 or 4 Rolls of old Newspapers, 1 used cardboard, Tacky Glue, 2 small flat wood dowel, tooth picks, Paper clips, Pencil, Eraser, Ruler/ tape measure, Bow compass for inscribing circles, Scissors, Straight Pins, Small paper plates, Paper Towel, Stapler, Masking tape

Spray Cans – paint, Acrylic paint, Glitter paint (optional) by choice of color

Adhesive, Gesso, Large and small paint brushes, one or two old toothbrushes
Lacquer, Clear coat sealer to protect duration – Optional

Decoration:

Contrasting the edges of the hats are the following –
Laces, ribbon flowers, silk, beads, feathers, buttons, glass stones etc.

Lining interface of an inner layer hat –
Provide a neat finish; the lining can be used to conceal interfacing, padding, raw edges and other construction details.

HOLDERS:

Hat pins, Fastens with combs, Side combs, Elastic band under head “one size fits all”

All materials can be purchased within location store or any art and craft store.

Students are welcomed and encouraged to bring their personal materials list samples

Safety, Cleaning Items Recommended:

Disposable Apron / Gloves, Safety Glasses, Paper towels, Old rugs, etc.
